“The “Baptism with the Spirit” is a historical event that took place on the Day of Pentecost, when Jesus baptized the believers present with the Holy Spirit.”

Definition

The “Baptism by the Spirit” is the act of the Holy Spirit placing the individual believer into the Body of Christ. Every believer receives this at the moment of salvation.
