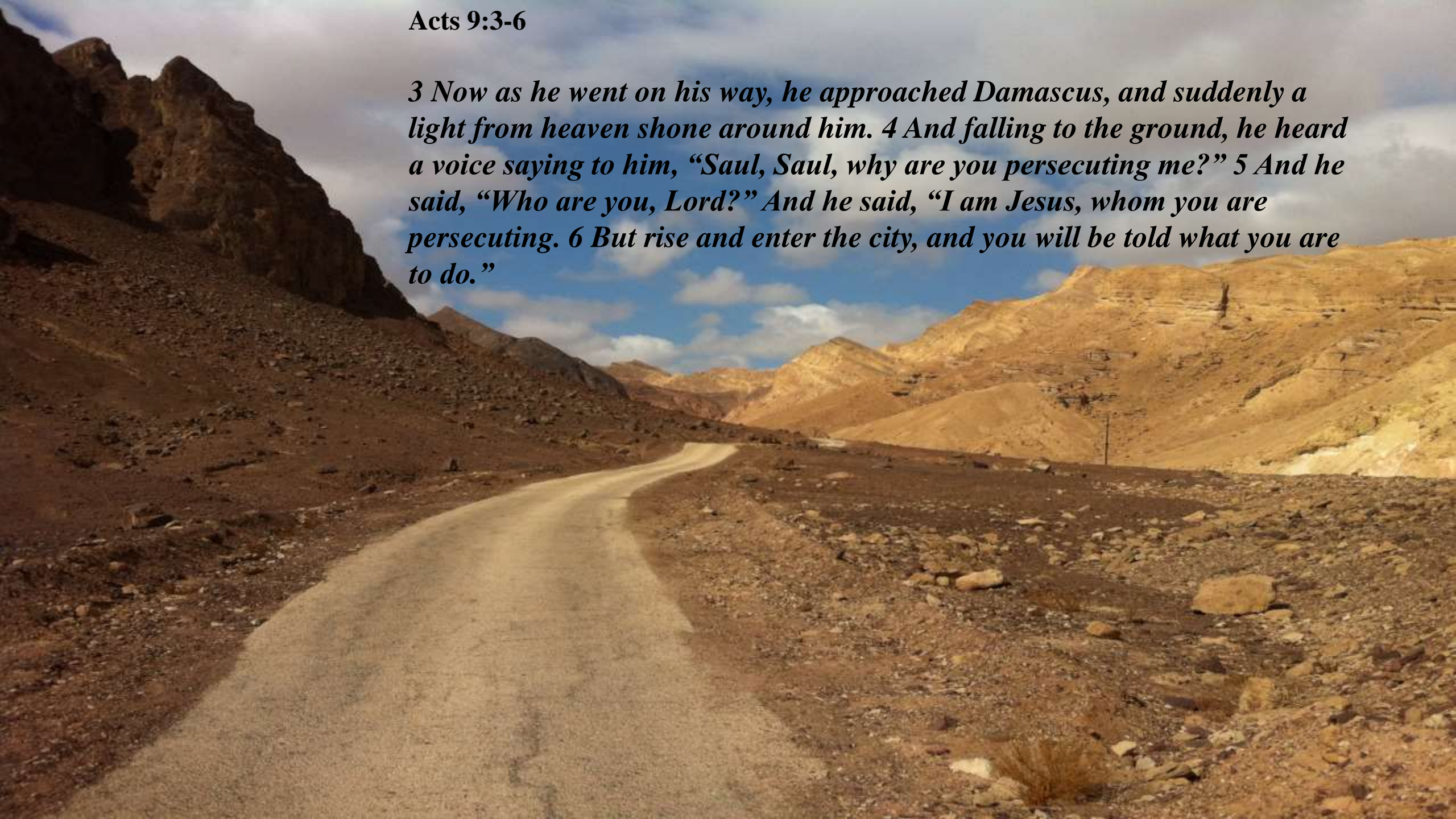




I. Paul

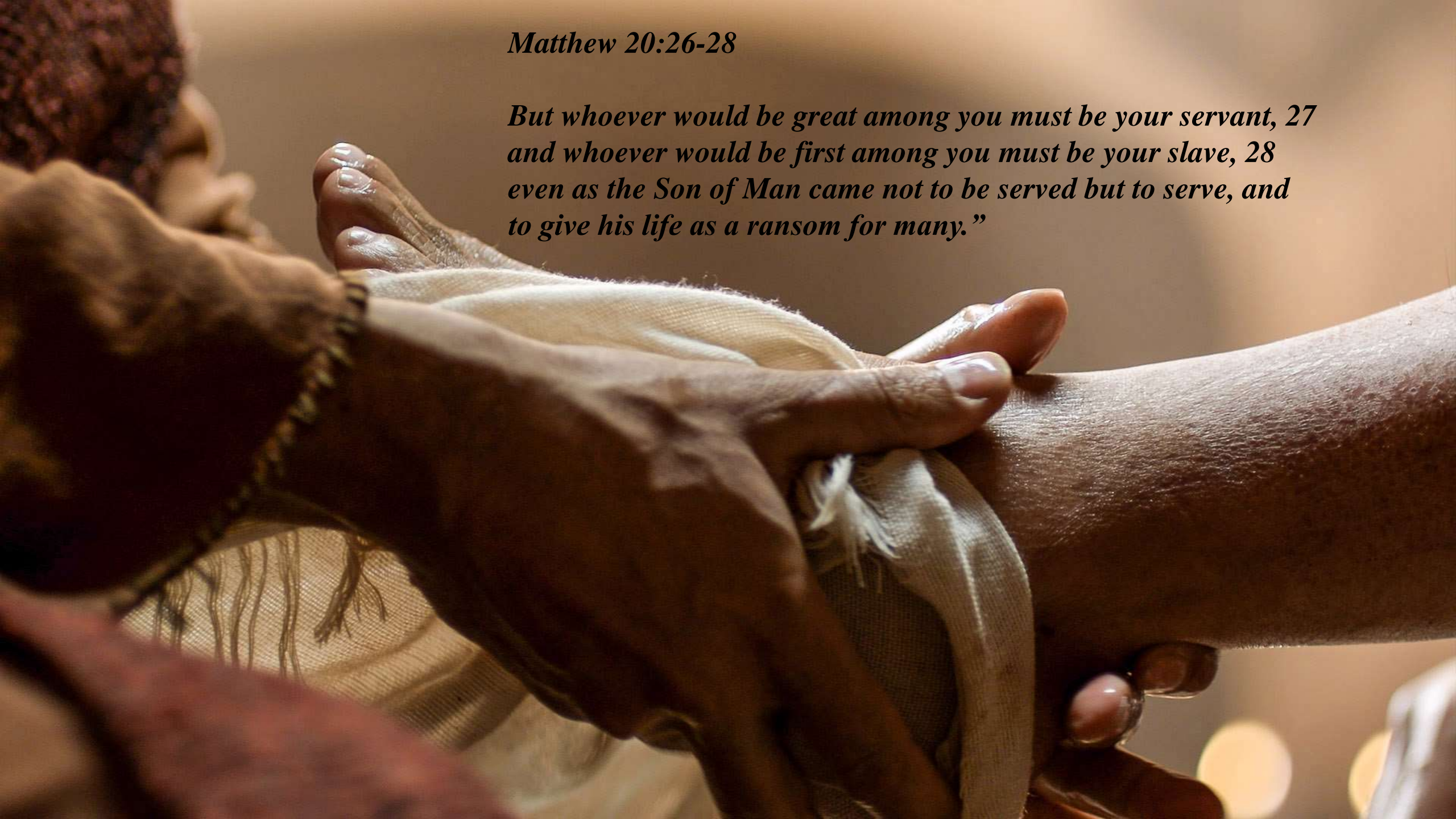
