James 1:2-4

Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, 3 for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. 4 And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing



JUDGES

1. Dependence on God Not Ourselves

Problem: Pride

Test One: Fearful Leave

Test Two: Kneelers Leave

32,000 - 22,000 = 10,000 - 9,700 = 300 300 vs. 135,000 (450 to 1)

2. Assurance in God Not Doubt

Gideon Responds:

1. He Worships

2. He Plans

3. He Leads

Dependence on God

= Assurance

Dependence on Ourselves = **Doubt**

God's Strategy: Evil vs. Evil

God' Victory: Victory in Jesus

Ephraim: Flatter them

Succoth: Whip them

Penuel: Kill them

5. Personal Revenge Not Godly Justice Justice is God's Not Ours Justice is Not Determined by us Justice is in the Cross

Romans 3:24-26 '...and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25 whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. 26 It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.'
