What does it mean to be a Shepherd?

Deuteronomy 6:6-9

6 These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. 7 Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. 8 Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. 9 Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.

1. Care for them

a. <u>Engage</u> in meaningful <u>dialogue</u>

b. Don't underestimate the power of a well placed question

2. Feed them

a. Feed them truth

Matthew 4:4 "Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"

b. Feed them <u>often</u>

Deuteronomy 6: 7-9 "When you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. 8 Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. 9 write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates."
