<u>Name</u>	<u>Meaning</u>	<u>Remnant Meaning</u>
Jezreel	“Scattered”	“Sand of Sea”
Lo-Ruhama	“No Mercy”	“Beloved”
Lo-Ammi	“Not My people”	“My People” & “Sons of the Living God”

1. God Acts Sovereignly

God Chose to Save a Remnant of **Israel**

1. God Saves a Remnant of Israel
2. God Judges the Nation
3. God Preserves the Remnant

God Chose to Save a Remnant by **Faith**

1. Righteousness by Faith

OR

2. Righteousness by Law

God Chose to Save a Remnant through **Jesus**

1. Jesus is Offensive

- a. Salvation is by Election
- b. Salvation is for Gentiles
- c. Salvation is by Faith
- d. Salvation is only for a Remnant
