The Sabbath Fulfilled

1. Jesus is **Lord of the Sabbath**
 - a. Jesus **Fulfilled Sabbath Law**
 - b. Sabbath Changed to **Lord's Day**

2. Jesus Gives **True Rest**
 - a. Sabbath is a **Shadow**
 - b. Gospel is **True Rest**

3. Jesus Invites us to **Rest**

*'Come to Me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you **Rest**.'* (Mat 11:28)
