a. We Will **Act** Right

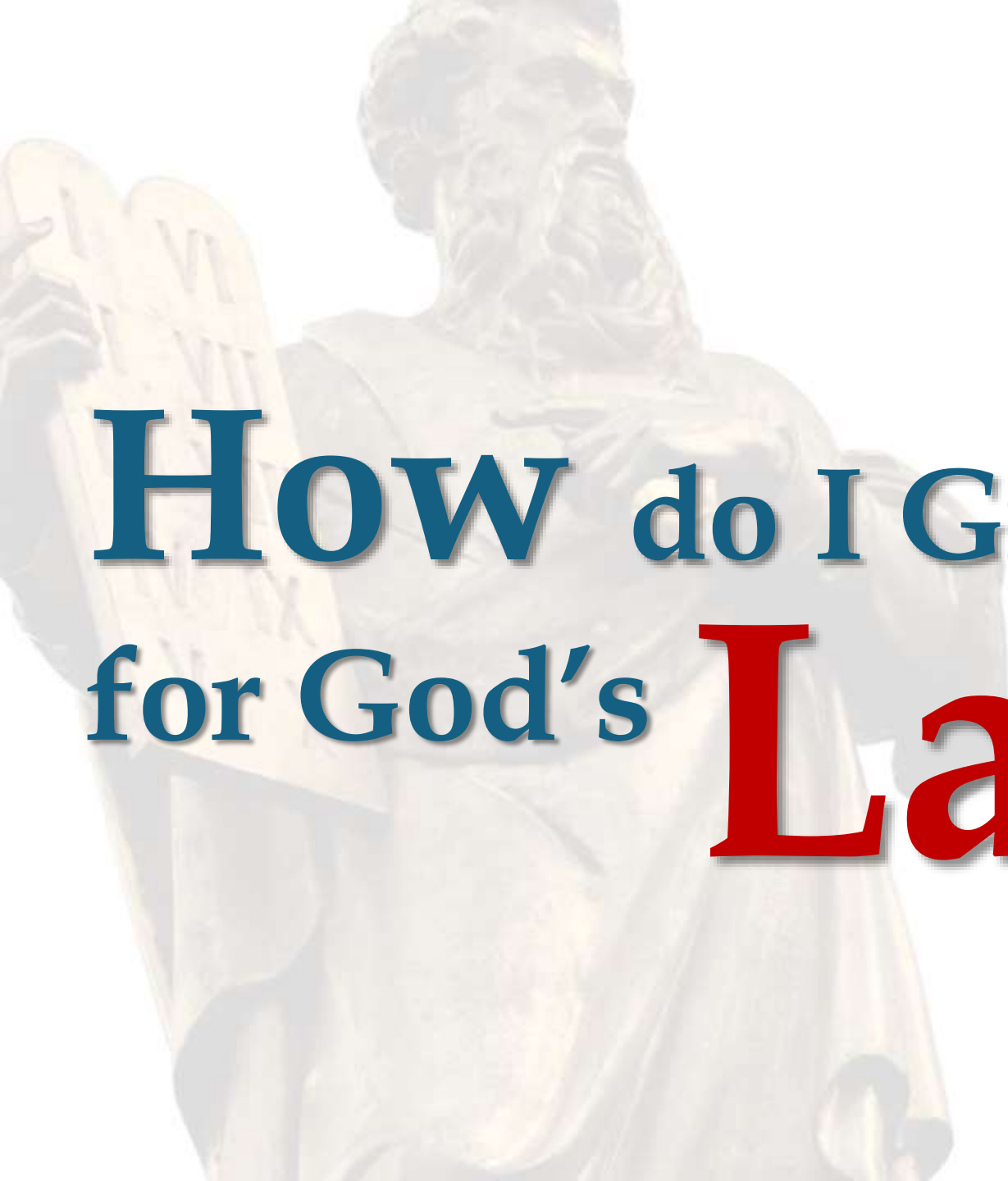
b. We Will **Think** Right
