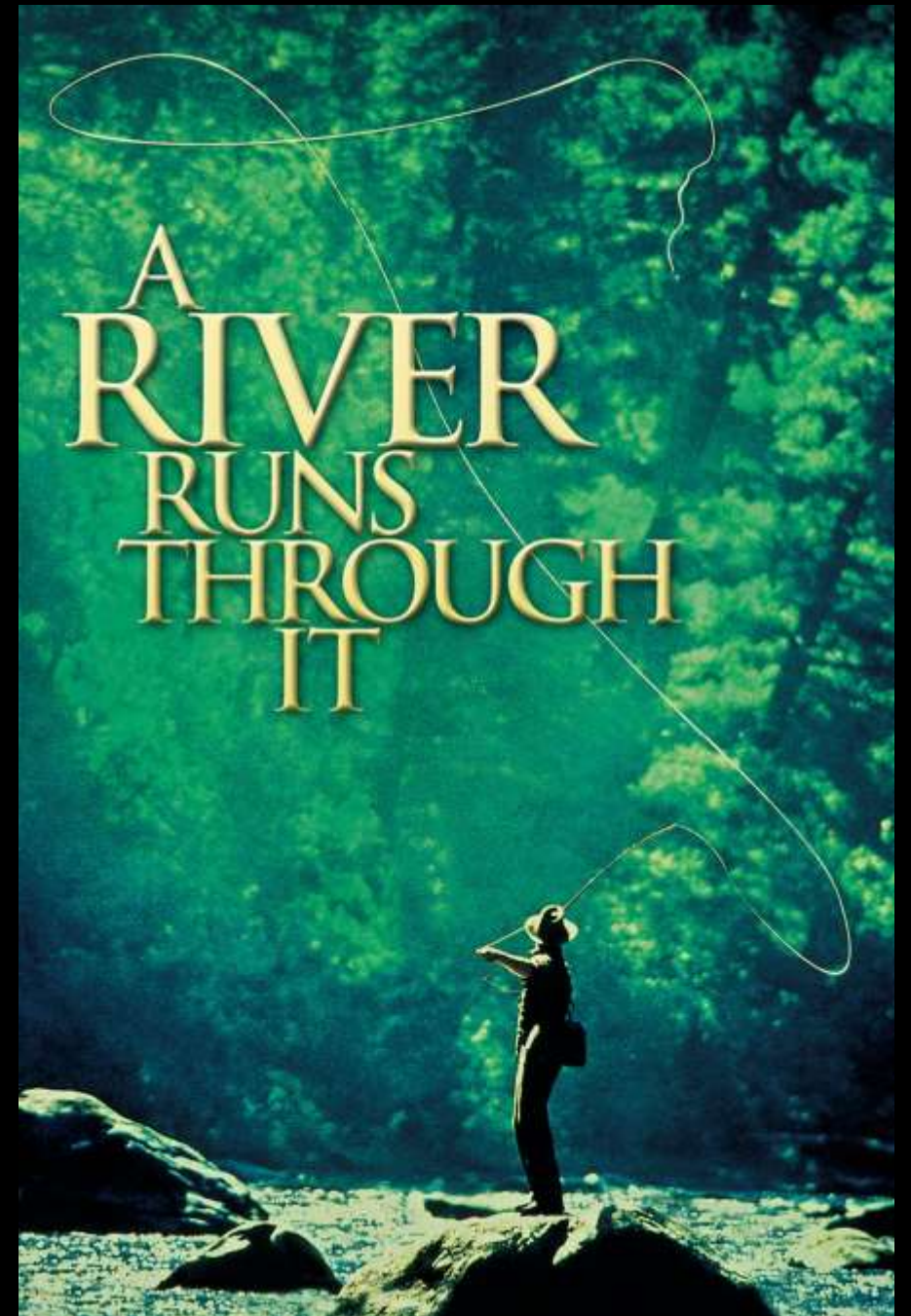
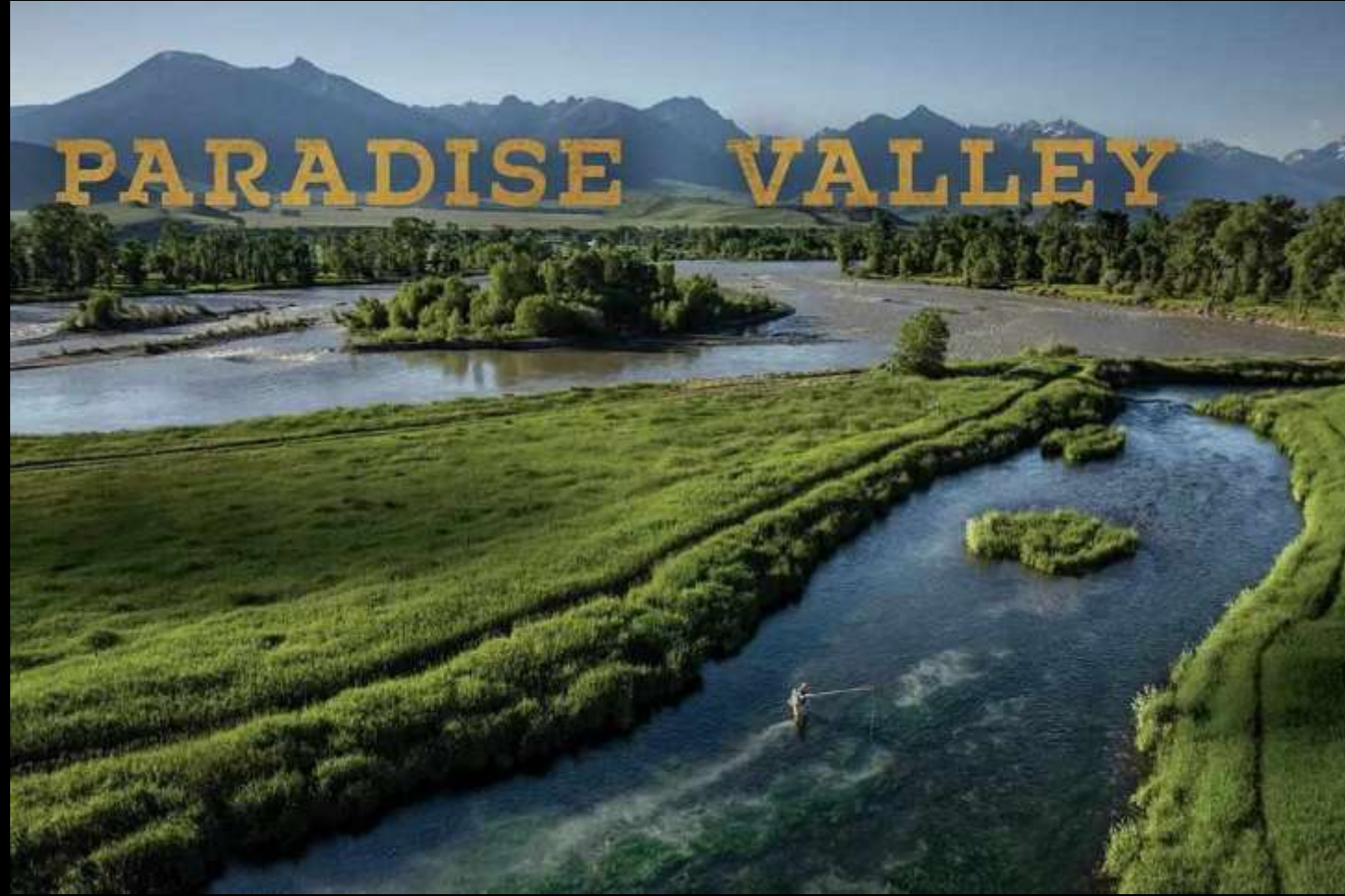

V. From Fish to Flocks (15-17)

When Jesus first asks Peter if he loves Him, He uses the Greek word “agapaó” which is a wholehearted, unconditional, fully-devoted love.

When Peter replies back, he uses the Greek word
“phileo” which was a term of warm affection

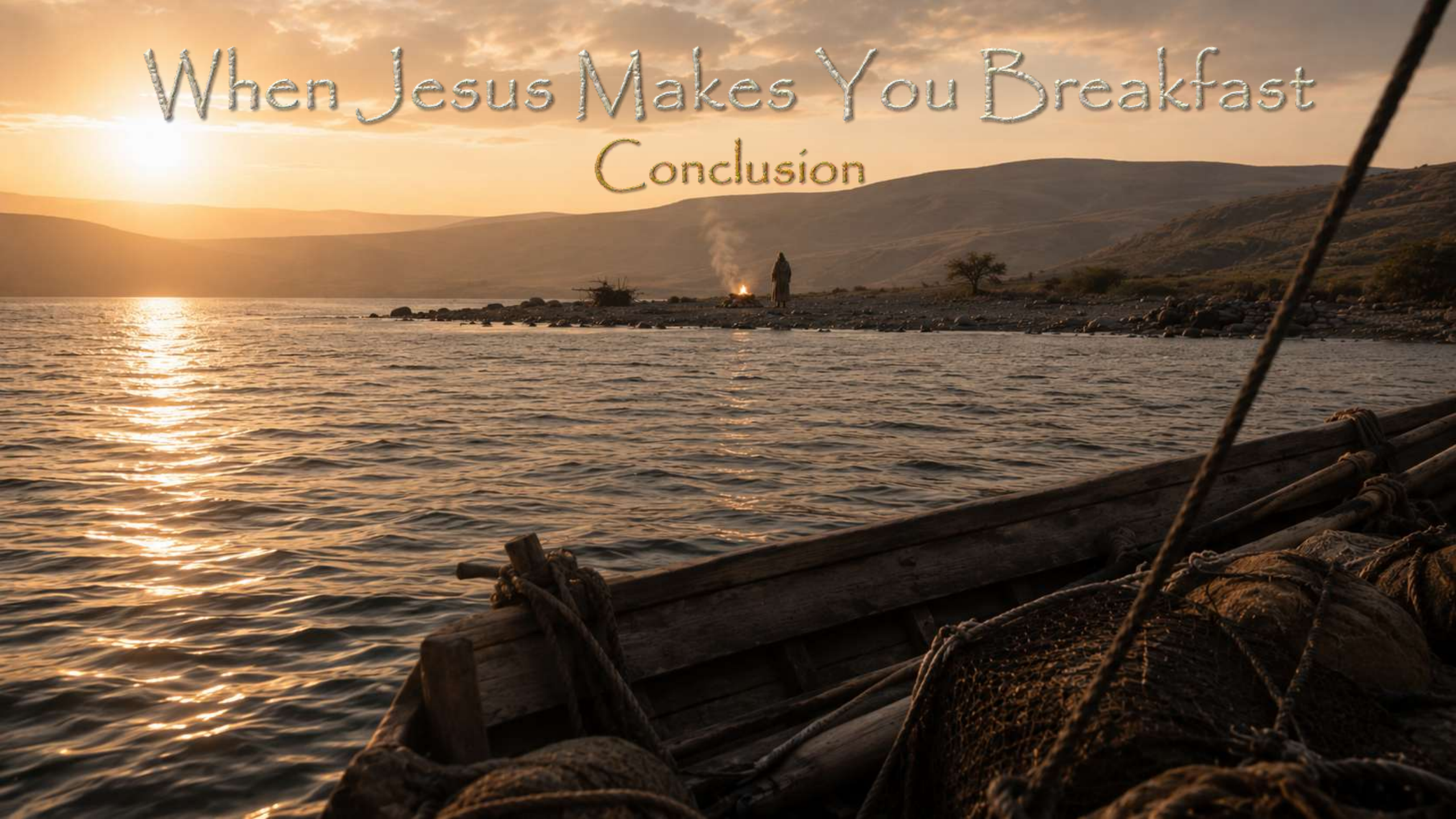
